Lake Babine Nation (“LBN”) requires an energetic, motivated, and caring **HOME SUPPORT WORKER for Ft. Babine Community** to assist our clients in their homes. The Home Support Worker is required to travel to client homes and is responsible for assisting clients with all aspects of home care including personal hygiene, daily activities, and emotional support. This individual keeps accurate client documentation and administers medication as required, under the supervision of the Nursing Supervisor or other designated Nurse.

The **Home Support Worker** assists clients with daily physical exercise and performs client transfers as needed (*e.g. transfer from wheelchair to bed*). The **Home Support Worker** assists clients with maintaining their independence and respects client dignity at all times. This individual must be highly adaptable to changing situations, a great communicator, and a responsible team player.

REQUIREMENT:

- Minimum Two (2) years' experience in health and client/patient care.
- Experience with in-home client care.
- Current CPR Certification required.
- Knowledge of and abilities in transferring, lifting, and other attendant care duties.
- Familiar with laws, regulations, and guidelines governing home health care provision.
- Computer literacy, including effective working skills of MS Word, Excel and e-mail required in order to complete related documentation.
- Physical ability to lift and support clients.
