## Notice pursuant to the Indian Band Election Regulations (CRC, c. 952)

Notice is hereby given that **Lake Babine Nation** has called an Election in accordance with its **Election Code (2003)**, for the purpose of electing: one (1) Chief; four (4) Woyenne Councillors; two (2) Fort Babine Councillors; two (2) Tachet Councillors; and one (1) Old Fort Councillor on June 26<sup>th</sup>, 2018 for the next ensuing Term of Office.

**PLEASE NOTE** that any eligible elector (voter) may propose or second a nomination of any other eligible elector (voter) to serve as a candidate for the office Chief or Councillor in accordance with the Lake Babine Nation Election Code in person at the Nomination Meeting. A candidate may not be eligible to run for more than one office in the Election.

Candidates **MUST** accept their nomination prior to the scheduled All Candidates Forums starting June 9th, 2018 – otherwise the candidate shall not be entitled to deliver a speech or to have their name appear on the Ballot. It is important that persons who seek nomination as a Candidate must complete all documentation and Candidate requirements pursuant to and in accordance of the Lake Babine Nation Election Code – it is the Candidates responsibility to be fully aware and understand all the requirements associated with running for elected office.
